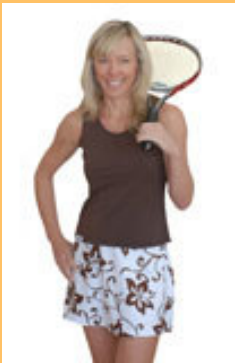

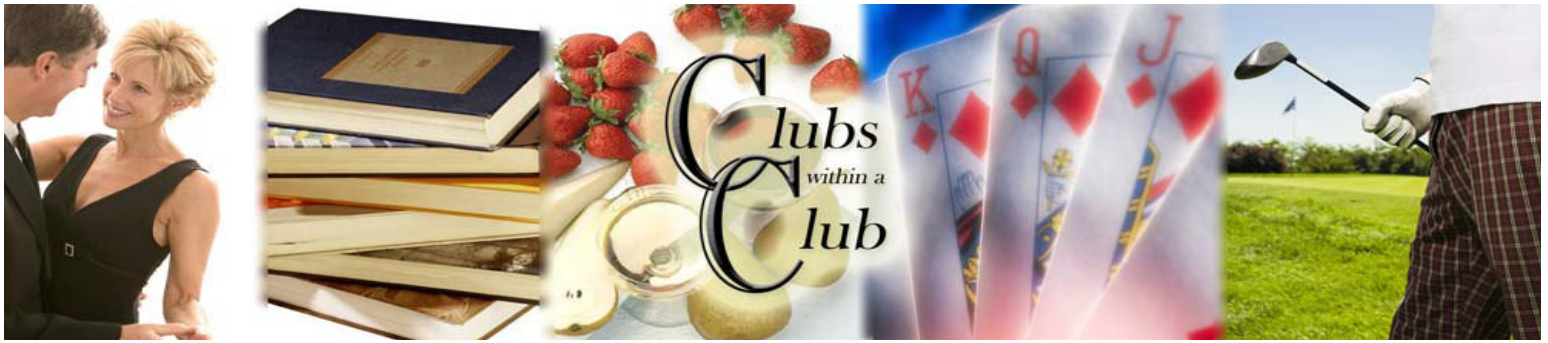

As a reminder, MGA members earn pro shop credit for high finishes in each tournament in addition to a payout for closest to the pin on each par three. With more players in each tournament the payout increases.

In addition to Pro shop credit earnings, MGA members earn points for the annual MGA Player of The Year Award. Points are awarded for the top ten finishes by team or individuals. 1st Place - 10 points, 2nd Place - 9 Points, 3rd Place – 8 points, etc. down to 1 point for 10th Place. 1 Point is also awarded to each player who participates in a tournament. In the past, 5 Points were awarded to a player who played in three tournaments in a row. This year we are modifying this to provide bonus points for playing in 3 events (5 Points), 6 events (10 points), 9 events (15 points), and 12 events (20 points). The player who accumulates the most points from November 2009 to October 2010 is the 2010 Player of the Year. The 2009 Player of the Year was David Dew in a tight race which came down to the last tournament. His margin of victory was a mere 5 points.

Lastly, the MGA is in discussion with Balcones staff to include an MGA member in the annual all expense paid trip to PGA National to compete against other APGM clubs. A preliminary plan is for the MGA member to be selected by MGA event participation, bringing in new MGA members, and, most importantly, bringing in new club members. More details will be provided upon finalizing the criteria. If you are not aware of the PGA National all expense paid trip, ask the 2009 players about it. Bill Buckner, Rodney Threet, Mickey Powell, Dave Westlund, and Bob Scoma will attest to the tremendous time everyone had at this event. All Golf members are encouraged to participate in this year's club sponsored qualifiers to earn a spot for the PGA National trip. With two courses, we are eligible to send two teams to Florida. The top point scorers in this year's qualifying tournaments will play in a final tournament at Balcones to determine the teams we send. It is proposed that the MGA participant will join the teams from the final event. Stay tuned for more information on this tremendous opportunity for an MGA member.
