If there are just a few couples participating, the game might be couple against couple. All monies are returned to winning players, but if you want to make a bunch go to giggle or gaggle. 
Summer brings exceptional new food menus and poolside service.

Pro's Corner

I'm thinking this is going to be a tough one. Summer I mean. We don't have a lot of control over what Mom Nature hands us, so, we've got to be prepared for the worse. Hydration, hydration and hydration is the key. If you have a choice, try to schedule your tennis earlier in the day, or in the evening. But even then, the heat can have a major effect on you. When playing, wear loose, light colored clothing, a hat, and don't forget the sunblock. On change overs, try to get out of the sun, even if it's by throwing a towel over your head. There's nothing better on a really hot day than to have an ice chest with cold towels to wrap around your neck. But the most important thing...keep the water flowing, constantly. If you start to feel faint, or sick to your stomach, get off the court. Don't try to finish the set, or even the game, just pack it up and get yourself cooled down. It's a long summer and there will be plenty of other matches to be played. Just remember to start hydrating well before you step on the court, keep hydrating as you play and even after you finish. Fall is only a few months off, you can make it.

Session 1 of the Summer Junior Camps will start June 6th. We'll have five two-week sessions throughout the summer. Students can either signup for specific sessions or signup for the Summer Pass and drop in anytime throughout the summer. We'll send monthly statements for classes attended to those players. 
Board of Governors


