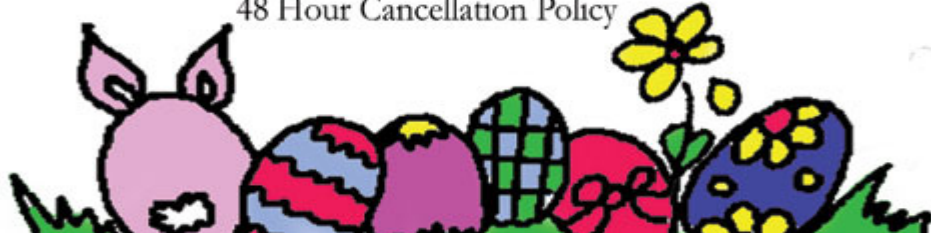

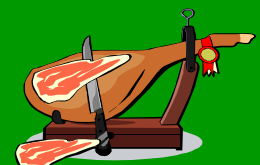

## From Chef Tony...

PANKO CRUSTED COD WITH A  
LIME/PARMESAN COMPOUND BUTTER

### INGREDIENTS

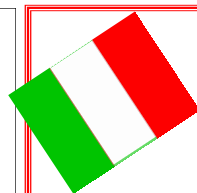
- COD FILETS
- BUTTERMILK
- 4 cups PANKO BREAD CRUMBS
- 1 cup FLOUR
- salt/pepper to taste
- 1/2 pound BUTTER
- 1 clove minced GARLIC
- 1/4 cup finely grated parmesan
- 2 LIMES(juice only)
- 4 sprigs of fresh THYME
- salt/pepper to taste

### METHOD

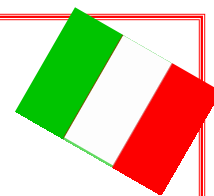
- Set oven at 400
- Soak cod filets in buttermilk for 1 hour
- In a large bowl mix panko, flour, leaves of thyme sprig, salt and pepper
- Remove cod from buttermilk and dredge through panko mix and place on a baking sheet lined with parchment
- Drizzle tops of fish with olive oil to achieve a good crust
- Bake for 7-10 minutes or till internal temperature of 140 then remove and top with whipped butter

### COMPOUND BUTTER

- Combined room temperature butter, cheese, garlic, lime, salt and pepper in a bowl and whip vigorously, kitchen-aid mixer with a whip attachment works the best
- Check flavor and add more of what's lacking, personal preference.
- Extra butter is great on chicken, steaks or pork chops, lasting in fridge for 4 days.

## Tee Time procedure at Balcones and Spicewood

How can you make sure that you get the tee times that you and your group want or something close to your wishes. This may have become an issue for you in the early part of the partnering with APGM. Let me reassure you that we want the members to have the first priority over any of our guests coming to enjoy Spicewood.

### *Spicewood:*

Members have the opportunity to make tee times 10 days in advance, including weekends, (3 days ahead of our daily fee guests). We also want to remind the members that play in with regular weekly groups that they are still responsible for making those times. We want our members to use as many tee times as they need before we open the tee sheet up to our guests. Once the 7 day window hits we are going to do our best to fill in the left over times with guests. So you need to make your times early and try to start thinking and planning ahead.

### *Balcones:*
