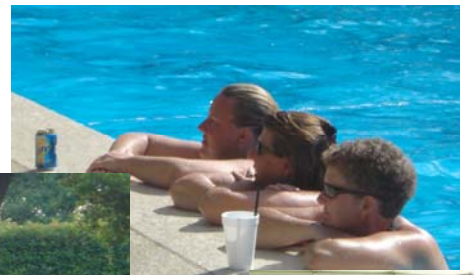

The foursome went undefeated in the Men's 50 division to capture the World Senior event held in Mallorca, Spain. The team format included two singles and one doubles for each round. Team USA won 3-0 over Switzerland, Japan and Estonia. In the quarterfinals, the Americans defeated Belgium, winning both of their singles matches. In the semi-finals, the Americans and Austrians were 1-1 after the singles match, but the Americans won the doubles 7-6, 7-5 to take the round. The finals pitted the Americans against the number one seeds, the Germans. Peter beat the number one German, Manfred Jungnitsch, 6-3, 7-6, to capture the World title. 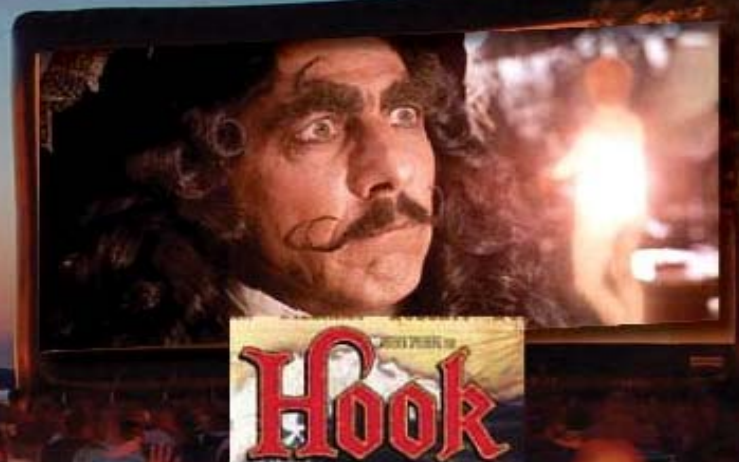

Grilled King Salmon with a
Key Lime & Shallot Butter

Ingredients

- 1 cup unsalted butter
- 2 tablespoons minced shallots
- 3 tablespoons key lime juice
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 4 (6-ounce) salmon fillets
- Cooked pasta or rice

Directions

Grill on lightly oiled grill grate over medium-high heat

In a saucepan, melt butter with shallots then add lime juice. Salt and pepper the salmon fillets on both sides. Place fillets onto grill, brush half of lime butter over salmon. Grill salmon until internal temperature of 135-145°. Drizzle remaining lime butter over salmon before serving. Serve with pasta or rice. Butter can also be infused with fresh herbs such as sage, basil or rosemary.
