### **Young golfer's honesty at tourney remarkable!**

I would like to share with you a part of this story about a young man playing in the Austin City Junior that was held at Morris Williams this year. This story was taken from the Austin American Statesman published on August 27, 2009.

Scores were being posted near the end of the first round when a 10-year old player approached tournament officials. He held back tears as he pointed out that an incorrect score had been posted for him, and he new that meant disqualification.

His playing partner, who had kept the players card, gave him a 4 on a hole where he actually made 7. The player did not check his scores closely enough, and quickly signed his card. Only when he saw the score posted did he see the mistake. He instantly new what he had to do.

The player was the only one who was aware of what had happened. He could have just walked away, and nobody else would ever have known. But he did the right thing. A tough thing to do, but the right thing.

"It's one of the most impressive, admirable things I've seen around here," the chief assistant at Morris Williams said. "It restores my faith in this game and what the game is supposed to be teaching these kids. There are a whole lot of adults who could learn a thing or two from this 10-year-old kid."

This story should make all the members at Balcones Country Club proud. This young man is one of our Juniors here at the club. He has been playing in tournament since he was 5-years-old. He has represented the Game of Golf in a very honorable fashion. I am personally very proud of this young man for his honesty and for playing by the rules. His parents should also walk with their heads held high for the job they are doing building character in their sons. Thank you for being a Major part of the Balcones Junior Program.
