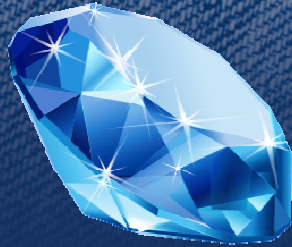

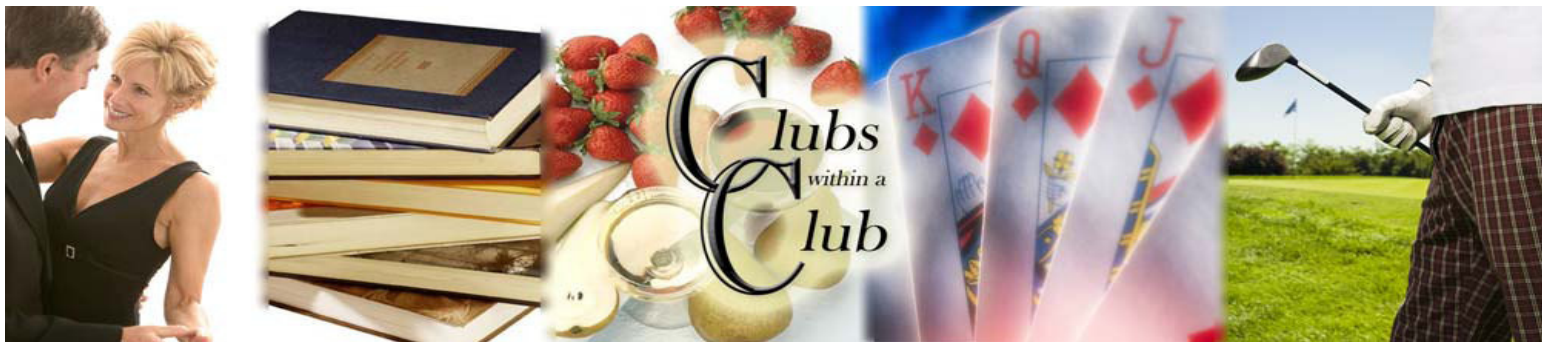

## **Handicap FYI ..... from your BCC Handicap Committee**

Our new Course and Slope Ratings we talked about last month are important updates for us. Next in line is an assessment of the "Allocation of Handicap Strokes" for each course. The allocation of strokes is a ranking from 1 to 18 indicating the difficulty of each hole with 1 being the most difficult. We use this information to determine where to apply handicap strokes in competition. Our current Allocation of Handicap Strokes is woefully outdated; they are at least 24 years old and have never been calculated for the White (old Gold) Tees.

To accomplish the new Allocation we have chosen a USGA method that requires collecting members scores for each hole played. With data from actual play we can accurately rank the difficulty of each hole. **So ..... This is why you are being asked to enter your scores by hole for every round played!** This is an important evaluation of our courses and we appreciate your participation.

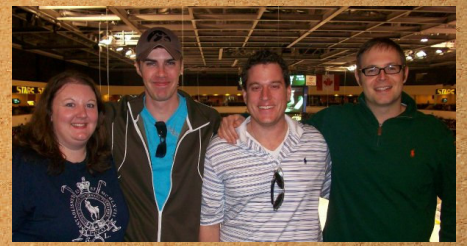
