First – welcome to all the new members of the Balcones family!

I want to thank all of you that have invited friends to join Balcones. Membership is growing, but we want to accelerate the pace, so we're offering you a special incentive to invite new members...

If you haven't heard about our membership promotion it offers you a chance to pay NO DUES in 2010 – while the new member only pays Social dues (\$90) through March.

Sponsor one new member, and you pay only half dues for 2010. Sponsor two new members, and you pay NO DUES for 2010. We've already got 3 members who'll pay no dues for 2010! (John & Loretta Voss, Greg Raper, and Susan Cooper). Tim & Gail Buckley and Mike & Sally Metschan are only going to pay half dues (so far).

I want to single out Ike Lee for the tremendous results in converting your leads into new members. 16 new members since he took over the membership role – during what's traditionally the slowest time of the year. We're now up to 441 full members and 802 total. Awesome job, Ike!

Balcones' continued growth is most dependent on getting our newest members involved so that they want to invite their friends to join. Please go out of your way to seek out the new faces and welcome them into the club and into any groups you're a part of.

For those members (new or old) that aren't full members – if you've ever considered upgrading your membership, we'd love to have you come out and meet the golfers. You can play an MGA event for only the entry fee – watch for the flyers at the club each month for the date and format (just sign up at the Pro Shop). The WGA also hosts regular events for the ladies. Ask the Pro Shop about other "open groups" – those that have regular times on the weekends (or during the week) that are open to all who want to play.

One last piece of business – I hear many questions about what's going on with the revenue and how APGM is spending the extra income from public play at Spicewood. Our contract with APGM calls for them to spend 3% of total income on repairs and improvements (outside normal maintenance). They've spent close to 9% this year. Many repairs and replacements that aren't obvious (pumps, carts, AC). But we've received 4 new tee boxes, new flatscreen TV, ball machine for Tennis – and new driving range mats and a verti-cut greens mower are on the way. The partnership with APGM is truly working out to be a great thing for Balcones.

Thanks again to all of you for being members at Balcones!

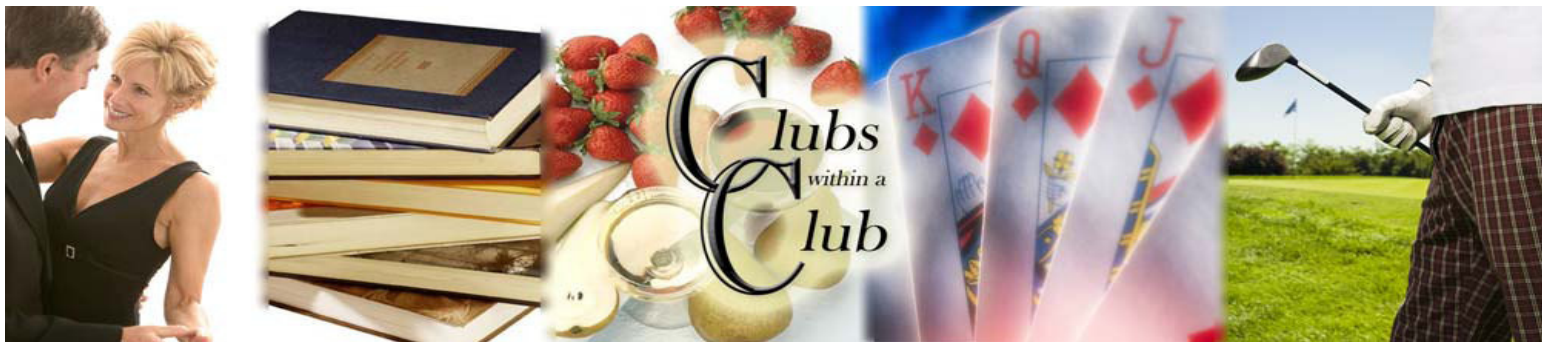

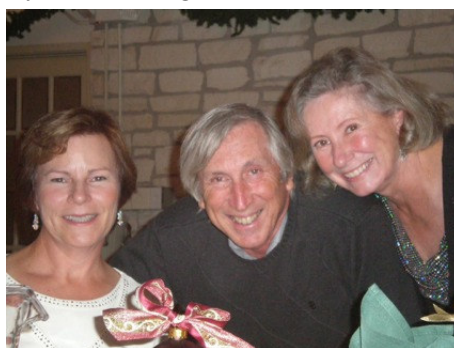
