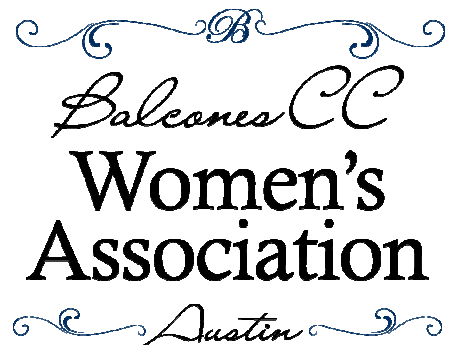

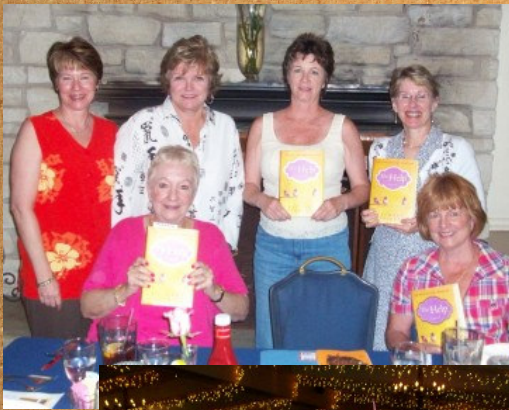

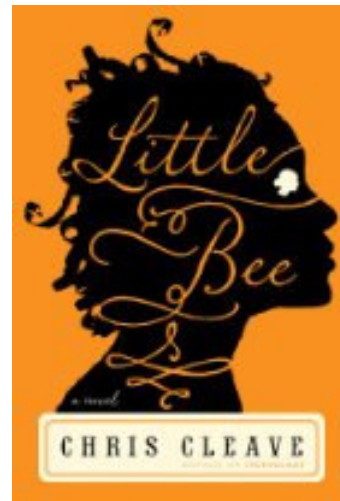

Handicap FYI from your BCC Handicap Committee

As you know, Equitable Stroke Control determines the maximum score you can record by hole for handicap purposes; the maximum score varies depending on your course handicap and can range from double bogey to 10. Why do we make this adjustment?

The USGA states "**This mandatory procedure reduces high hole scores for handicap purposes in order to make handicaps more representative of a player's potential ability.**" That is certainly true. However, there is another reason and that is to minimize handicap manipulation; i.e., sandbagging, where a person blatantly ignores the USGA handicap premise of giving your best effort on each shot.

Early in my golfing life, I played in an industrial league after work. The game was 9 holes, Match Play. My 9 hole handicap was 14. One day I played another 14 handicapper who scored par on most of the first five holes and closed me out; he then scored 8's and 10's on the next four holes to assure he kept his 14 handicap. This, of course, was before Equitable Stroke Control. The USGA stopped this practice with the introduction of ESC in 1974.
