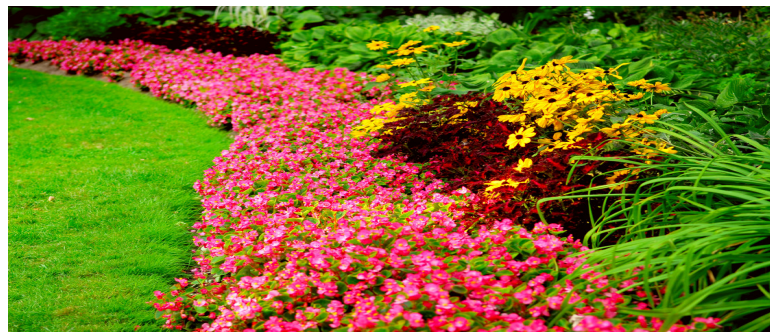

There’s never been a better time for your friends to join us here at Balcones. Thanks again to all of you for being members at Balcones!



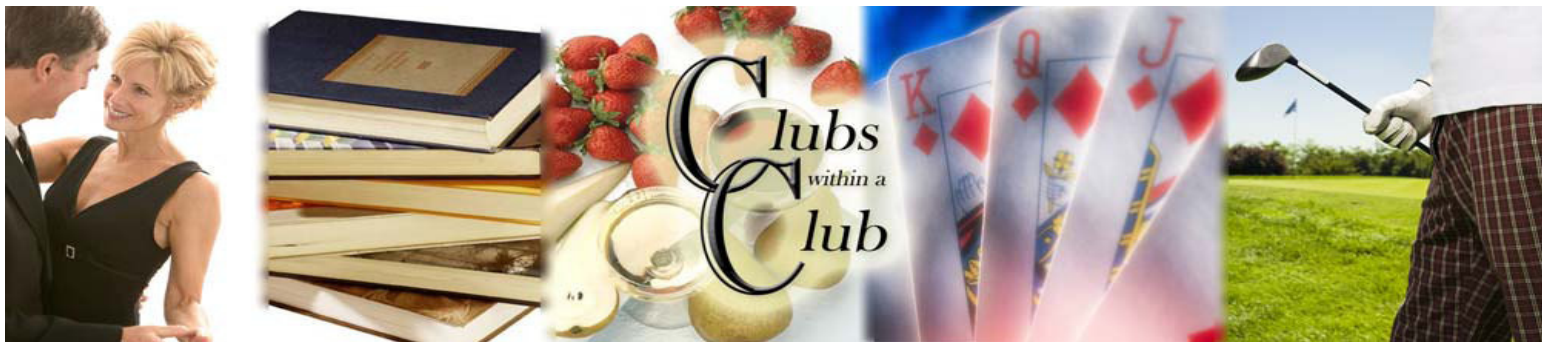

Handicap FYI from your BCC Handicap Committee

Balcones and Spicewood were recently evaluated by the Texas Golf Association and have new Course Ratings and Slope Ratings for each set of Tees. These are reflected on our new scorecards.

The Course Rating is the playing difficulty of a course for a scratch golfer.

The Slope Rating indicates the measurement of the relative difficulty of a course for players who are not scratch golfers compared to the difficulty of a course for a scratch golfer. The higher the Slope Rating, the more difficult the course. The Slope Rating can be as low as 55 and as high as 155, the standard rating is 113.

The first Course Rating System was developed by the Ladies Golf Union in Europe about 1900. The first USGA Course Rating System was established in 1911. Slope Rating was introduced in 1981.

Working on these limitations can improve your overall golf performance and lower your scores. Golf fitness training will improve your coordination, flexibility, and stability in your core, hips, and shoulders. It will improve your balance and decrease your risk of injury. Also, golf fitness training can help improve cardio and overall blood flow through your body, and most importantly it will add more POWER with less EFFORT!

If you come to train with me I use kettlebells which trains coordination, builds flexibility, cardio, stability, and power. TRX training, Swiss ball, free motion, free weights, and plyometrics are all part of the overall program.
