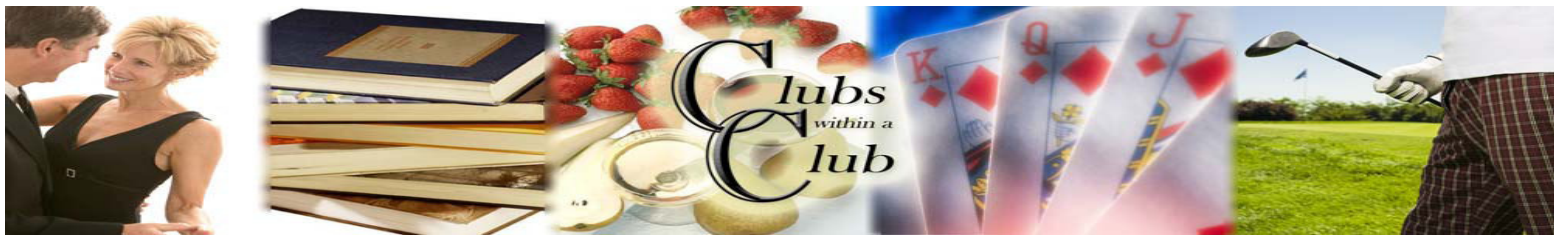

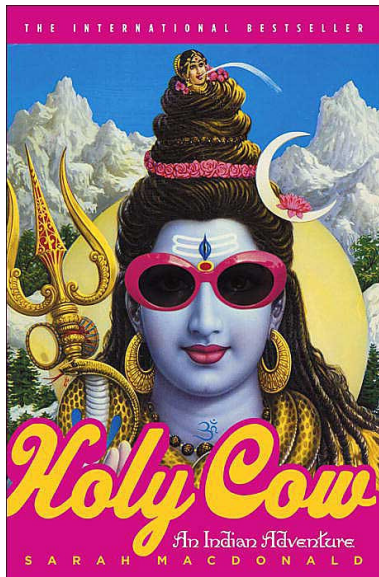

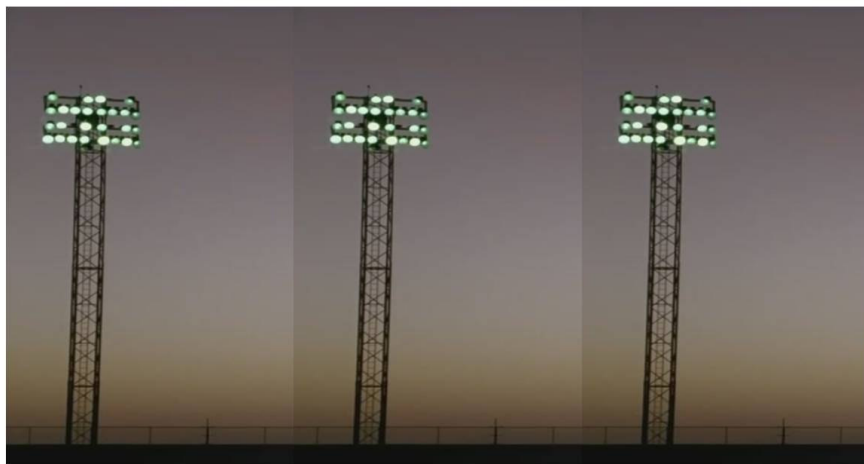

Board of Governors... by David Westlund

The Board of Governors has come up with our first project. With help from APGM, we will begin to improve curb appeal at BCC.

We are working to make the Club a place that you are proud to bring your friends and family to enjoy the atmosphere and visit with fellow members. We will also begin some tennis and tee box beautification improvements to improve the club experience.

At first, projects will be small but money will be set aside for each of the big projects that touch all of our hearts. We want everyone to know that we are making improvements at Balcones so come join us and enjoy the excitement. Stay tuned.

Handicap FYI from your BCC Handicap Committee

Course Par was used to establish handicaps in the first attempts to provide a handicap system. It quickly became evident that this did not work; Par is a different standard on different courses. Some courses are just tougher than others. So an 18 handicap established playing the Spicewood Blue Tees would be very different from an 18 established on the Pebble Beach Blue Tees which is a much more difficult course ; and, if these players met at the same course, the player from Pebble would have a big advantage.

The USGA recognized this problem and has corrected it with Course Rating and Slope. The Course Rating is the score a scratch player is expected to shoot; the slope is a measure of the difficulty of the course for a bogey golfer compared to a scratch player. The USGA Handicap System is based on these two parameters and the gross score a player records for each round played. A Player's Handicap Index is calculated from these factors . **Note that Par is not in the calculation of Handicap Index and plays no role in the USGA Handicap System.**

Each Tee on every Course has a unique Course Rating and Slope; each Tee is a different Course being played and provides a different Course Handicap for the player. **It is very important to recognize that the Net Score of a player who plays to his Course Handicap will be the Course Rating, not Par; this is the way the Handicap System is built.** This is the reason there must be a handicap adjustment when players are competing from different tees. The adjustment is the difference in the Course Rating where the players from the more difficult Tees get an increase in Course Handicap.

This subject has been discussed a lot the past few months at Balcones. Yes, the USGA Handicap System requires us to determine our Course Handicap from the Tees we are playing and, then, to adjust that Course Handicap if we are competing with players from different Tees. This is in the spirit of equitable competitive play. Hope this helps.
